

## Francisco Middle School SSC Meeting, Dec 14th, 2017

Review and discuss the three proposals that were submitted to be the lead agency partner for our Beacon After-school Program.

Meeting starts at 4:35 PM

Mr. West talks about the Beacon program - They have been involved with SFUSD for 7 years.

- Francisco is one of the two middle school at SFUSD that has a Beacon program
- Beacon's funding comes from 3 different sources
- SFUSD decides to make changes and expand Beacon and offer their services at more schools
- At Francisco we already have Beacon
- Today we're discussing our current CBO provider and looking at two other agencies
- Each school site will consider the different options, give their feedback, and the principal will make the final decision.
- It will be implemented next school year
- Francisco doesn't have a say in the budget it doesn't come from our budget
- The budget is is determined by the CBO, state, and the city

Our options

- A. Keep Beacon our current provider
- B. Option B - CYC
- C. The boys and girls club at SF - BGCSF

Alli: Everybody says that they will support our school, they sound great. But will they actually do it?

Mr. West: Is there a good reason to change our after school program? I didn't see anything from proposal B or C that they can do much better job than our current CBO?

Ali: I would like to hear from the students.

Antonio(student) : I did the leadership program with Beacon and I was completely happy.

Isabella(student): We should stay with TEL HI, I play soccer with them on three teams.

Hilda: I know about the three programs the best one is Beacon. They are involved in the community and I have a deep connection with Beacon. So far, TEL HI has been the best, they know a lot about what's going on.

Sofia( student): They cycle through different programs such as sports and art classes.

A parent: My daughter is there, she never practiced sports and cooked before, but at Beacon she is doing it.

Ali: Beacon study/ homework room is too loud with Beacon there are things to be improved.

Mr. West: Beacon works closely with the school to match the school's goals.

Ms. Personius: Beacon has hired teachers to work with the students.

Hilda: Beacon provides Latino and leadership clubs supports outside of school.

Crystal: I was thinking that proposal B CYC is the good one Garfield has that one ( their numbers are up to a 100 % and they have a better pay).

Ms. Personius: CYC has the lowest pay for direct service staff.

Ali: Beacon had a lot of new staff last year, this year as well, that's a problem in general.

Hilda: This just happened, just this year they have been pretty consistent.

Ms. Noe: I had a student that took a class at CYC and he participated in a literacy workshop he usually doesn't participate in classroom discussions.

Mr. West: Our students go to CYC, the go to the BGCSF. Galileo's after school program is runned by TEL HI.

Hilda: TEL HI is for low income families, integrates everybody, and offers: poetry, meditation, and more.

Mr. Kuang: CYC and BGCSF are proposing much smaller budget. Currently, Beacon is proposing much bigger budget that implies more or higher quality services.

Mr. West: The money are proposed by the CBO, also the agencies propose their own budget.

The numbers proposed by the agencies are:

CYC: \$470, 000

BGCSF: \$573, 520

Current Beacon: \$815, 633

Mr. West So far, what can we get out of here and ask TEL HI to improve their services.

The first choice is Beacon

- Crystal: I had a great experience with CYC, higher pay for staff.
- A Parent: Outreach and helping parents to be more involved, lights on after school.
- Ms. Noe: CYC seems to bridge the families and the school, support group for parents, they provide resources.
- Ali: Is there a way to create a parent space? May we create that space?
- Hilda: We need to tell them what we need to improve the program.
  
- Students: Promotion planning, spirit week.
- Ms. Monova: Having an 8th grade student's designated space to do certain academic and fun activities.

- Ms. Monova: Adding elective classes that students can't take during the school day.
- A Parent: Family room for services and family support such as eviction.
- A parent: my daughter told me that they will start drawing with the iPads that's what I am interested and have a club.
- Ali: VAPA do arts related subjects that are not offered during school. Bring outside resources such as teachers and other specialists.
- Angela: Garfield CYC provided different art and dance classes.
- Mr West: Our Beacon has it here, as well.
- Ali: May we have a language program other languages such as French, Spanish etc?
- Angela: I would like to know if the school will provide classes on photo, film making and editing, I am interested of these activities for my kids.
- A Parent: Any chance they can expand Beacon on weekends?  
Stronger academic support - more accountability for students to complete work.
- Ms. Personius: More academic support on homework from Beacon. Strict HW support class for newcomers, quasi mandatory ( they need something fun as an academic enrichment such as a fun academic elective).
- Ali: One last request: Celebrate the Black History, we should be celebrating the Latino History, Lunar New Year, I would like to see more cultural school-wide celebrations and bring outside support
- Angela: Make a story pictures and celebrating more the different cultures at school.
